Do you know whose portraits appear on America's paper currency – or how those honored individuals earned their fame? Check out the names and bios below to find out!

\$1 BILL - GEORGE WASHINGTON

The first president of the United States, George Washington became famous for helping America gain independence from Britain during the American Revolution.

\$5 BILL - ABRAHAM LINCOLN

Abraham Lincoln was the 16th president of the United States. He held the Union together during the Civil War and was instrumental in ending slavery in America.

\$10 BILL - ALEXANDER HAMILTON

Alexander Hamilton was one of America's founding fathers and played a major role in the national ratification (or approval) of the Constitution.

\$20 BILL - ANDREW JACKSON

Andrew Jackson was the seventh U.S. president and led his country to victory in the War of 1812's Battle of New Orleans. As a major general, he was a military hero. As president, he was known for supporting the American workers' hard-earned dollars and going up against big banks and corporations.

\$50 BILL - ULYSSES S. GRANT

Ulysses S. Grant served as a leader of the Union army during the Civil War and in 1869 became the 18th president of the United States.

\$100 BILL - BENJAMIN FRANKLIN

A scientist, author, inventor, postmaster, diplomat and more, Benjamin Franklin helped to write the Declaration of Independence as well as the U.S. Constitution.

Start Saving Today

Deposit money to your APCI FCU account between April 15-19, 2024, and help us celebrate Credit Union Youth Week. Remember, when you deposit money into your Savings Account, you earn dividends. Dividends are like interest; it is the money you are paid for keeping money in your account. Saving today will help to make your dreams come true!

Parents and Guardians: Encourage your child to keep saving by depositing \$10 or more during Youth Week, and they will automatically be entered into a drawing to receive a \$25 credit to their account.¹

Deposits can be made through our APCI eBanking Mobile App using the APCI eDeposit service, in person at the credit union, or by mail to APCI FCU, PO Box 20147, Lehigh Valley, PA 18002-0147.

One entry per eligible member per day for a deposit of \$10 or more. Mailed deposits must be received no later than 4/19/24. One winner will be selected on or about 4/30/24 and will be notified. The winner will receive \$25 deposited into their Primary Share Savings Account no later than 5/10/24. Member accounts must be open and in good standing to receive the incentive. Immediate family and household of APC IFCU staff and volunteers are not eligible. Member incentives that are paid for opening a new account or for making a deposit into an existing account are subject to 1099-INT reporting requirements. If incentives paid plus any dividends paid to you total \$10.00 or more, you will receive an IRS 1099-INT form for the current tax year. Any applicable taxes are the responsibility of the member.
