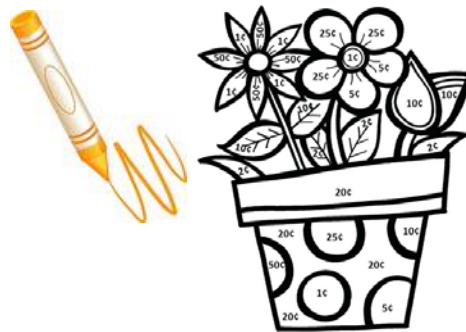
- a. A charge or cost

Deposit money to your APCI FCU account the week of April 16-20 and help us celebrate Credit Union Youth Week. Remember, when you deposit money into your Primary Share Savings Account at the Credit Union you earn dividends. Dividends are similar to interest; it is the money you are paid for keeping money in your account at the Credit Union. So, it makes CENTS to save today!

Parents and Guardians:

► APCI FCU will deposit \$5 in every new Primary Share Savings Account that is opened during Youth Week.¹ To open an account for a minor online, visit apcifcu.org > **APCI eJoin** > **Become a Member** > **Other**.

► If your child¹ is already a member, encourage them to deposit \$10 or more during Youth Week, and they will automatically be entered into a drawing to receive a \$25 credit to their account.²

Deposits can be made through APCI eDeposit service; at the Credit Union; through inter-company mail to APCI FCU at A11A1; or via US Mail to APCI FCU at PO Box 20147, Lehigh Valley, PA 18002-0147.

¹ Promotion is open to all eligible members up to 18 years of age.

² One entry for any deposit of \$10 or more per eligible member per day. Winners will be selected on or about 5/1/18 and will be notified. Member PAUTMA Account must be open and in good standing to receive the incentive. Winning entries will receive \$25 deposited into their Primary Share Savings Account no later than 5/8/18. Mailed deposits must be postmarked no later than April 20, 2018. Immediate family and household of APCI FCU staff and volunteers are not eligible.
