What is APCI ePay?

APCI ePay is an easy, fast, and secure way to pay and manage all your bills in one place. You can pay virtually anyone in the United States, from your cable provider to your babysitter. Staying organized is easy when you group similar payments into categories, such as household or subscriptions.

When enrolled in APCI ePay, you have the option to receive bills online rather than through the mail. Not only is it easy to manage your bills this way, but it is also environmentally friendly, secure, and convenient. You can set email reminders to notify you when a bill is ready to be viewed and also when it is due.

For bills that stay the same each month, like your mortgage, car loan, or cable bill, take advantage of the automatic payment feature. By using this feature your bill will be paid each month automatically. Need to make sure you made a payment? Your bill history is at your fingertips. You can search for past payments by company, date, and status.

APCI ePay Security

Paying your bills online is a great way to protect your personal and financial information. By paying online, instead of mailing paper checks, you reduce the risk of fraud and identity theft.

On top of the safety added by simply paying bills online, APCI ePay uses FraudNet to provide improved fraud prevention capabilities. FraudNet analyzes daily bill payment transaction data, compares the data to suspicious fraud scenarios, and examines the APCI ePay user's behavioral patterns.

When fraud is suspected, our experienced representatives can hold processing of suspicious payments until the transaction can be verified as fraudulent or authentic. A representative may contact you with questions. You may be asked to verify your name and address but will never be asked to provide your Social Security number.



How to Enroll

All members aged 18 or older with a Checking Account are eligible to enroll in APCI ePay. You can self-enroll in APCI ePay by completing the following steps:

1. Log in to APCI eBanking > Pay Bills
2. Select your S0004 Share Draft Checking Account and click "Submit"
3. To complete the self-enrollment process, you will be asked to verify your personal information, verify your payment account number, review the terms and conditions and click "Enroll"

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Is there a fee to use APCI ePay?

A: No, APCI ePay is free.

Q: Will I be able to access APCI ePay in the APCI eBanking Mobile App?
